SEATTLE – United Way of King County, following the recommendations from Seattle & King County Public Health regarding the spread of the new coronavirus, has temporarily closed all Free Tax Preparation sites.

Our first priority is the safety and well-being of our staff, volunteers and guests. According to Public Health guidelines, the best way to slow the spread of the virus is by "social distancing," or reducing the number of people in close public contact.

We would like to encourage taxpayers who still need help with their taxes to visit www.myfreetaxes.com, where eligible households can complete simple returns free of charge. The online tool is offered in partnership between United Way and H&R Block.
