» Why Partner?

During the school year, children rely on schools for more than learning—they also access meals, hygiene items, and consistent support. When summer begins, many of these resources disappear, leaving families to fill the gap. Pack the Bus is a community-wide volunteer event that brings corporate partners together to help meet these immediate needs. Employee teams will help assemble 2,500 food, hygiene, and summer activity kits that will be packed on a bus and delivered to local schools. Staff will distribute them to elementary students who need extra support during the summer months.

This hands-on experience allows employees to see the immediate impact of their efforts while ensuring students have what they need without stigma. Kit contents are recommended by Communities in Schools of Greater King County (CIS), a nonprofit providing individualized support to 39 schools across South Seattle, Renton, Issaquah, and Lake Washington.
