## Streets to Home

- Background: United Way of King County is building a community where people have homes, students graduate and families are financially stable. We know that the barriers preventing people from leaving the streets are as varied as the people themselves. Whether a result of domestic violence, medical challenges, job loss or something else, when someone becomes homeless, it's a true personal crisis. We also know that the sooner people move off the streets, the less likely they are to fall back into homelessness.
- Streets to Home: Streets to Home provides outreach workers with flexible funds so that they can individualize the support to move people off the streets and into stable housing. One person may need help removing an eviction from their record, and another may need help with a security deposit. When launched, the program focused on single adults that are homeless, and housed 584 people in the first full year of operation. United Way is now taking the program to scale, bringing on more partners for outreach and serving additional populations.
- **Opportunity:** An investment in Streets to Home will support the expansion of the program, growing from 11 service providers offering outreach to 20 and moving 1,000 people off of the streets and into stable housing.
