BACKGROUND

Too many people of color are left out of leadership roles. For more than 25 years, United Way has been working to change that. Project LEAD—Leadership, Effectiveness and Diversity—is an indepth, four-week training program that provides participants with the skills and tools to effectively guide a governance board in today's changing environment. The program utilizes the services of top professional trainers who volunteer their time. Project LEAD takes a step further to actively match these skilled volunteers with nonprofit boards and committees.

Project LEAD is an opportunity for people of color to further develop their leadership and management potential while serving the community. Over 61 percent of past graduates say they acquired leadership skills that translated into their professional lives. The program also strengthens the governance capacity of local nonprofit organizations by providing board members who are diverse, understand their responsibilities and possess the skills to lead an organization.
