BACKGROUND

<u>The Black Community Building Collective</u> started in fall 2020 as a participatory funding approach to invest in Black-led organizations. This funding model shifts the decision-making power to those closest to the need and lets them decide how the funding is invested. This group of 15 Black nonprofit leaders—who know their communities best—will determine how this funding is directed in order to support equitable recovery and the long-term viability of King County's Black community.

In an effort to shift power to the Black community, United Way has invested \$3 million over two years and has committed an additional \$1.5 million in 2023 for the Collective to invest as they see fit.
