WHY INVEST?

According to a recent U.S. Census Bureau survey, nearly 133,000 adults in the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue metro area say they are behind on rent or mortgage and do not expect to be able to pay next month. But if there's one thing we can all agree on about our region's housing crisis, it's this: We all want to see progress.

At United Way, we believe that the best way to fight homelessness is to prevent people from becoming homeless in the first place.




We intentionally focus on the prevention and reduction of homelessness through some of our programs like Home Base, which focuses on helping people avoid eviction.

- We get the word out about the availability of rental assistance, a crucial step in stopping the future pipeline into homelessness, to as many people and communities as possible.
- We work with tenants, landlords and other parties to help negotiate a payment plan for past rent, fees and other dues.
- We fight for tenants' rights, represent tenants in eviction court and provide other eviction protections to renters.

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we've helped improve rental assistance processes to get more money out the door and have advocated for eviction moratoriums, moratorium extensions and increases in federal rental assistance.

With the eviction moratorium in Seattle ending and the King County Eviction Prevention and Rent Assistance Program on pause, thousands of households are still on the waitlist for rental assistance. As prices of essentials continue to soar, we only expect these numbers to grow. With your support, we can get ahead of a swell of evictions and help families stay in their homes and avert a crisis.
